All Saints Memorial Chapel

The All Saints Home was founded by the All Saints Memorial Chapel in 1986, with the aim of providing residential nursing care in a Christian environment for the elderly and sick of all races and religions. This mission driven, not-for-profit organisation is anchored on three fundamental beliefs; providing resident-focussed care, holistic care and individualised care to all residents.

The All Saints Home partners with their staff, residents and their families to create a caring culture and to raise the standards of care for the elderly. The All Saints Home currently operates in two locations and is in the process of building two new homes in Singapore. These new homes will expand their capacity from their current 337 beds to 731 beds by the year 2015.

Challenge

The All Saints Home, Tampines began as a modest care facility, with a 30-bed home. The Tampines Home has grown to house 180 beds and a Day Rehabilitation Centre, this home was built with government subsidy and opened in 2001. Other All Saints Homes have been built at full cost to the not-for-profit organisation.

The All Saints Home provides comprehensive and professional care services with a multidisciplinary team of staff who work together to identify, plan, implement and evaluate comprehensive resident-centred care. The team of healthcare professionals include medical doctors, nurses, occupational therapists, physiotherapists, dietitians, and healthcare support personnel. Further support is offered by their team of counsellors, chaplains and volunteers.

All Saints Hospital was looking for an updated solution to their nurse call system in their Tampines site.

Meeting challenges of specialisation:

- All Saints Home required a nurse call solution that would fit with the existing legacy system installed in the facility.
- All Saints Home was looking for an affordable upgrade path that would allow them to update their nurse call system as their budget allows.





Challenges and technical considerations

A number of technical challenges were faced by CarePlus™ Partner Meditech Asia Alliance in designing a CarePlus™ solution to meet the challenges of All Saints Home, Tampines.


